### Product Purpose or Use

40 Below Window Tape & Masons Butyl Tape is a self-adhered, flashing tape designed to protect windows penetrations from moisture infiltration. When integrated into the wall system and used properly, the tape will provide a secondary defence against water penetrating. 40 Below Window Tape can also be used as a Rigid Air Barrier Tape.

### Subject to the following Conditions & Limitations:

- a. 40 Below can be applied in temperature ranges of between -40c to +65c.
- b. Ensure all surfaces to which 40 Below Window Tape & Masons Butyl Tape is applied are clean, dry and free of dust.
- c. 40 Below Window Tape & Masons Butyl Tape is to be applied only in areas as described in the Masons 40 Below Window Tape Installation Instruction April 2014 and on the packaging. It should not be used in areas where it has the potential to be exposed to heat such as chimney flues.
- d. When applying 40 Below Window Tape or Masons Butyl Tape to LOSP treated timber, ensure the solvent has been allowed to flash off prior to installing the product. It is suggested that a minimum of one (1) week is allowed for.
- e. 40 Below Window Tape & Masons Butyl Tape when used, installed and maintained in accordance with the requirements outlined in 40 Below Window Tape technical brochure April 2014, contributes to the requirements of Acceptable Solution E2/AS1, Clause 9.1.5 (b) (i).
