

Contractual Building Work Complaint

Section 21, Summary Proceedings Act 1957

You can use this form to make a complaint about the contractual requirements set out in Part 4A of the Building Act 2004.

Please read before completing this form

A complaint regarding Section 21 of Summary of Proceedings Act 1957 must relate to one or more of the following:

- no contract for building work worth more than \$30,000; and/or
- no disclosure statement and/or prescribed checklist before entering into a contract; and/or
- no prescribed information at the conclusion of the building work.

If your complaint meets the above criteria, you must provide evidence that supports your complaint. You can only make a complaint about contracts entered into after 1 January 2015. Section 21 of the Summary of Proceedings Act 1957 sets out that an infringement offence is only practicably enforceable when the offence occurred within 6 months of the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) being notified. Each infringement can be subject to a fine of \$500.

Upon receipt of this form MBIE may make any necessary enquiries so that decisions can be made regarding this complaint. This may include the necessary disclosure of the information to third parties.

If your complaint does not meet the criteria set out above and relates to building work, there are other complaint avenues that may suit your concerns.

- Licensed Building Practitioner complaint: You can make a complaint to the Building Practitioners Board (the Board) about work undertaken by a Licensed Building Practitioner. Please note, the Board does not resolve commercial disputes.
- **Non-Licensed builder complaint:** You can make a complaint to MBIE about restricted building work undertaken by a non-licensed builder.
- **Disputes Tribunal of New Zealand:** You can contact the Disputes Tribunal for matters relating to overcharging, damage to property or other matters of unsatisfactory service delivery.
