All of the Acceptable Solutions and Verification Methods relating to G1 are contained in one document.

- G1/AS1 provides a means to show compliance for the number and location of personal hygiene facilities in occupied buildings. It gives a method to calculate numbers of sanitary fixtures. It gives design solutions for the means of constructing and installing sanitary fixtures; flushing systems; examples of accessible facilities layouts; cubicles and lobbies.
